

Lane County Sector Strategy Team Performance Metric Dashboard

Below are recent achievements in Lane County as a result of the collaborative efforts of the Lane County Sector Strategy Team (LCSST):

Business Oregon has **awarded RAIN Eugene a \$59,537** High Impact Opportunity Project Grant to begin designing the Southern Willamette Valley Food Business Development Center. **Micah Elconin, Lane Food and Beverage Sector Strategist**, is collaborating with RAIN Eugene on the project.

Lyft and Uber launched in September 2018, which marked the culmination of years' worth of daily work for **TAO staff and partners**.

On August 15, the Building Codes Division adopted rules creating provisional licenses for general journeyman electricians and limited journeyman manufacturing plant electricians, as well as administrative licenses for limited journeyman manufacturing plant electricians, and limited maintenance electricians. *** Each license has individual lists of transferable states**

Lane Workforce Partnership (LWP) and **Elevate Lane County** have transitioned the LWP School to Career Task Team to an Industry Advisory Group for Elevate Lane County.

For the first time last year **Connected Lane County** had a middle school fair, which included 45 different local businesses. All of the targeted sectors were represented. A total of **2,586** students attended.
